**You will be required to fill out and send in additional paper work including:** a medical history form, parental consent if a minor, as well as a photo copy of your driver's license / ID. Some of these items will need to be notarized. These forms will be sent to you in a separate mailing.

### **Interviews**

Interviews will be conducted at FOL in Dublin Ga. on Saturday January 21<sup>st</sup> and at Youth Quake in Adrian Ga. on Saturday afternoon Feb 18<sup>th</sup>. If you cannot make one of these interview times please call to reschedule another interview appointment. Space is limited and if you are interested you should contact Debbie Moody as soon as possible.

**Financial Agreement:**

If accepted for this Georgia Youth W&W trip, I understand that my final payment for the total cost of the trip is due no later than May 21, 2012. We will send you a payment plan schedule. All checks need to be made payable to **Georgia District NMI** and mailed to Debbie Moody, 103 Ashwood Court, Leesburg, Ga. 31763.

I understand there is a \$50 deposit (this is included in the total cost of the trip) that is non-refundable if I'm selected and decide not to participate. I also understand the cost of this trip does not include transportation to and from the Atlanta airport or spending money while on the trip.

**Rules for ALL Participants:**

- \* Each team member should act in such a way that they are an example of Christ.
- \* All members follow the guidelines set in the manual of the Church of the Nazarene and respect the culture we are visiting, to include refraining from the following:
  - \* No men wearing earrings, no one drinking alcohol, using illegal drugs, smoking, dancing, foul language, complaining, or dating nationals during the trip.
  - \* Guys and Gals are NOT to be in each other's rooms.
  - \* No tank tops and items with spaghetti straps or no straps. No halter tops.
  - \* NO FLIP FLOP OR RUBBER THONG TYPE SHOES. Most gym shoes or leather soled boots will be ok for hiking and daily wear. No open-toed shoes or sandals while working on the job site or doing minor construction projects.
  - \* Casual dress for services and VBS. Slacks, Jeans, Polo's. All skirts and dresses must be at least knee length or longer (if the dress or skirt is made of material that is see through please wear a slip). Shorts may be worn during R&R but they must be at least mid-thigh length or longer.
  - \* Do NOT wear expensive clothes or jewelry – Don't flaunt it. Don't TAKE THEM!!!! Leave your tech gear at home.
  - \* The temperatures will be in the 60's-70's during the day, cooler in the evenings. You may want to pack a sweat shirt and jacket.
